



Air Force ROTC Foreign Language Express Scholarships



Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps provides excellent scholarship opportunities in all areas of study. This year the Air Force is providing great scholarships to people in certain critical areas of study, which opens a door for students to receive a pre-approved scholarship if he or she meets the minimum requirements outlined in this fact sheet.

What is a Foreign Language Express Scholarship?

Foreign Language Express Scholarships provide pre-approved scholarships to individuals in certain areas of study for which the United States Air Force projects a critical need in a few years. Scholarships in these areas are guaranteed if students meet all minimum requirements. This program awards Type 2 scholarships paying up to \$15,000 per year tuition, \$600 per year for books, and \$250 to \$400 monthly stipend, depending on enrollment year.

Who is Eligible?

The needs of the Air Force are always changing and so does the eligibility for Foreign Language Express Scholarships. Currently, Air Force ROTC is offering Foreign Language Express Scholarships in the following majors:

What are the Requirements?

In order to receive an Express Scholarship you must be in one of the areas of study listed in this fact sheet, have a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) to be submitted and a 2.5 grade point average thereafter. Additionally, you must be able to pass a Department of Defense physical, pass the physical fitness test, the Air Force Officer Qualifying Test, and obtain an endorsement from the Penn State Air Force ROTC detachment commander. Also, you may not have been a previously contracted cadet.

Great Opportunity for a Limited Time

Air Force ROTC provides an outstanding opportunity for students to receive a 3-, or 2-year scholarship. Express Scholarships are offered on a first-come, first-awarded basis, so it is important that you make a decision to apply as soon as possible. The Express Scholarship is one of many scholarship programs Air Force ROTC offers.
