Required Documents to Submit to the Financial Aid Office

- Upperclass Foreign Citizen Financial Aid Application** for 2008-2009.

- Financial Aid Activity and Demographic Supplement** – to be completed by the student.

- Parents' 2007 Wage Statement** from their employer or a national Tax Return if applicable. **If the tax documentation is in another language, please circle figures for total income and total taxes and mark them accordingly.**
- Student's 2007 US Federal Income Tax Return** (if filed), signed and complete with *all schedules and W-2's*.
If you did not file a 2007 US Federal Income Tax Return, please submit a signed statement to that effect.

Supporting documents due in the Financial Aid Office if applicable

- CSS Business/Farm Supplement**, and corresponding *corporate or partnership tax returns* complete with all schedules.
- Noncustodial Parent Information:** if parents are divorced or separated, each must complete a separate Upperclass Foreign Citizen Financial Aid Application and set of tax documents or wage statements.

Additional Information that may be submitted to the Financial Aid Office

- Letter of Special Circumstances-** If the information we have required you to submit does not accurately reflect your family's financial situation, or if you believe a particular circumstance should receive special attention, we suggest you write a separate letter and enclose it with the documents that you submit to us.
- Leave of Absence-** If you have taken a leave of absence during your years at Harvard, please write a brief note indicating the semester(s) that you were enrolled and enclose it with the materials you submit to us.
- Expected Enrollment-** We will assume that you will be enrolled for the academic year (both fall and spring) unless you notify us in writing of a change in your enrollment for the 2008-09 year.

Late Fees: As of **July 1, 2008**, any student whose application is incomplete will have a **\$150 late application fee** charged to his/her term bill account.

Eligibility: Students who complete applications **after September 1, 2008** are **ineligible** to receive financial aid for the fall term. If you have extenuating circumstances that will delay the completion of your financial aid application, contact your class officer as soon as possible.
