### **Instructions and Deadlines for U.S. Citizens, Canadians, or Eligible Permanent Residents**

**Forms to be filed on-line** (we recommend you file these forms by March 21<sup>st</sup>)

- CSS PROFILE** – File on-line at <https://profileonline.collegeboard.com/index.jsp>  
The CSS code number for Harvard is **3434**. Complete all sections of the application, including supplemental questions.
- Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** (for US Citizens and Eligible Permanent Residents only) – File the FAFSA on-line at <http://www.fafsa.ed.gov> using your Personal Identification Number (PIN) sent to you by the Department of Education. If you have lost your PIN or never received one, you can request one at <http://www.pin.ed.gov>. Our Federal School Code is **E00468**. **Please keep track of your PIN information from year to year. You will need it every year that you apply for financial aid.**
- Financial Aid Activity and Demographic Supplement** – Visit <http://admin-apps.fas.harvard.edu/faads.html>.
- CSS Noncustodial Parent PROFILE** – Instructions for non-custodial parents will be sent to the student after the regular PROFILE is completed.

**Supporting Documents to be submitted to IDOC** (submit forms by April 18<sup>th</sup>)

*Once you file your CSS PROFILE, you will receive a cover letter from the College Board that will guide you through the process.*

- Parents' 2007 Federal Income Tax Return**, signed and complete with *all schedules, W-2 and 1099 forms*.
- Student's 2007 Federal Income Tax Return, if filed**, signed and complete with *all schedules, W-2 and 1099 forms*.

**If you or your parents did not file a 2007 US Federal Income Tax Return, you must complete and submit a verification of non-filer status, available here: [http://fao.fas.harvard.edu/downloads/non-filer\\_statement.pdf](http://fao.fas.harvard.edu/downloads/non-filer_statement.pdf).**

- CSS Business/Farm Supplement** and corresponding *corporate or partnership federal tax returns* with schedules.

**Additional Information that may be submitted to IDOC**

- Letter of Special Circumstances-** If the information we have required you to submit does not accurately reflect your family's financial situation, or if you believe a particular circumstance should receive special attention, we suggest you write a separate letter and enclose it with the supporting documents that you submit to The College Board's IDOC Service.
- Leave of Absence-** If you have taken a leave of absence during your years at Harvard, please write a note indicating the semester(s) that you were enrolled and enclose it with the supporting documents that you submit to IDOC.

**Late Fees:** As of **July 1, 2008 and each month thereafter (July & August)**, any student whose application is incomplete will have a **\$150 late application fee** charged to his/her term bill account.

**Eligibility:** Students who complete applications **after September 1, 2008 are ineligible** to receive financial aid for the fall term. If you have extenuating circumstances that will delay the completion of your financial aid application, contact your class officer as soon as possible.

**Loan Only:** If you do not intend to apply for grant aid from the College, but would like to renew your loan(s), you need only to file the FAFSA. Please notify us of your decision by April 17, 2008.
